The legal voters of the Town of Hartland, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at Damon Hall in the Town of Hartland on Tuesday, August 11, 2020, between the hours of Seven o'clock (7:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article of business:

ARTICLE I

Shall the Town of Hartland be authorized to reconstruct and reconfigure the Route 12 and Route 5 intersection, including utility relocation, at an estimated cost of One Million Four Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,425,000), and to finance the Town's share of the cost of such improvements, after application of available state and federal grants-in-aid in the estimated amount of Three Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$363,000), through the issuance of general obligation notes or bonds in an amount not to exceed One Million Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,062,000)?

The legal voters of the Town of Hartland are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said special meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.


The legal voters of the Town of Hartland are further notified that an informational meeting will be held on Monday, August 3, 2020, remotely, at Five Thirty o'clock (5:30) in the evening, for the purpose of explaining the proposed improvements and the financing thereof. 
