

DAMON HALL ASSOCIATION.  
CONSTITUTION.

1. Name. The name of this Association shall be The Damon Hall Association.
2. Object. The primary object of this Association shall be to promote the use of Damon Hall in every way that will in the judgement of the members tend to develop the best social, moral, intellectual, and spiritual resources of the community. In pursuing this purpose the Association shall have power to raise money to complete the furnishing of the Hall to maintain the furnishings, and to establish such funds ~~from~~ ~~time~~ ~~to~~ ~~time~~ as may be deemed wise from time to time to carry out this primary object of the Association. The members shall determine by their majority vote whether or not any ~~action~~ proposed action is in accord with this object and such affirmative vote shall be decisive in determining the power of the Association under this constitution to take the said action.
3. Members. All persons signing this constitution before Jan. 1, 1917 shall be deemed charter members of this Association. After that date members may be admitted upon signing the constitution.
4. Officers. The officers shall be President, Vice-president, and Secretary-Treasurer. They shall be elected at the annual meeting in October, and shall hold office until their successors are chosen.
5. Committees. The officers shall constitute the Executive Committee.
6. Meetings. There shall be two meetings of the Association. <sup>yearly</sup> The Annual meeting shall be held in October for the election of officers. The semi-annual meeting shall be held in April. The dates shall be stated by the Executive Committee. Other meetings may be called at any time by the President, and member of the Executive Committee, or by five members of the Association.
7. Quorum. Five members of the Association shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
8. Amendment. This constitution may be amended at either the annual or semi-annual meeting of the Association by a majority of the members present and voting, provided such amendment was proposed at the previous annual or semi-annual meeting.
