

**ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE ROAD SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

**TOWN OF HARTLAND, VERMONT**

1. The Selectmen of Hartland in the County of Windsor and the State of Vermont, acting under the authority of Title 24 VSA, Section 2291 (4), hereby establish a maximum speed limit of 35 MPH on all town roads, unless otherwise posted, within the boundaries of Hartland.
2. This speed limit has been adopted to promote public safety and welfare, reduce the accident potential related to excessive speed.
3. Fines for violations of this ordinance shall be as provided in Title 23 VSA, Chapter 11 and 23.

This ordinance was adopted on September 19, 1988, and will become effective on November 18, 1988. The ordinance has been posted in five places in Town and may be inspected at the Town Clerk's office in Hartland between 9:00 – 12:00 and 1:30 – 4:30 Monday to Friday.

Title 24, Chapter 59 VSA, Sections 1972 & 1973, provides that the rule will become effective 60 days after signature. However, "an ordinance or rule adopted by a municipality may be disapproved by a vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the municipality voting on the question at an annual or special meeting duly warned for the purpose pursuant to a petition signed and submitted in accordance with subsection (c)." Subsection (c) states that "a petition for vote on the question of disapproving an ordinance or rule shall be signed by not less than five percent of the qualified voters of the municipality and presented to the legislative body within 45 days following the date of adoption of the ordinance or rule by the legislative body.
