Winter Road Maintenance Information

Plow routes are designed to open major traffic and bus routes first. Deviations from established routes only occur in emergencies.

Overnight operations begin at 2 AM and each of the five routes takes 5 hours to complete. Sanding and/or salting each route requires 3 hours.

Treatment of paved roads begins with ± 1 inch accumulation. Plowing unpaved roads begins with ± 3 inches of accumulation. Below 20°, salt is ineffective and will not be used.

Dog Licenses

By Vermont State Statute, all dogs must be registered with the Town Clerk by April 1 each calendar year. The fee is \$11.00 for spayed or neutered and \$15.00 for un-fixed dogs registered by April 1st. After April 1st, licensing is \$13.00 for spayed or neutered and \$19.00 for un-fixed dogs.

### **Burning Permits**

By town ordinance, a burning permit is needed for all open fires of natural wood. A burn permit can be obtained Monday-Friday from 8 AM-4 PM, when weather conditions allow, by contacting the Town Office. On weekends or for multi-day permits, contact a town fire officer. Phone numbers for Town Fire Department officials can be found on the town website under 'Hartland Volunteer Fire & Rescue.'

### **Services offered at Damon Hall**

1. Notary Services - bring unsigned documents and proof of identity.
2. Car Registration Renewals - bring a check for the renewal fee and \$3.00 for the service with your renewal stub.
3. Copies - 25 cents each for documents not covered by statute.

### **Building or Renovating In Hartland?**

If you are planning to build or renovate please call our Town Clerk's office 436-2444 to get further details on permit fees. The Town of Hartland also requires a driveway permit for new driveways attaching to town roads.

Any applicable state permits must be obtained before construction. Contact the State Department of Environmental Conservation at [dec.vermont.gov/environmental-assistance/permits/specialists](http://dec.vermont.gov/environmental-assistance/permits/specialists) to determine what state permits you need.

### **Got Trash?**

Hartland is a member of the Greater Upper Valley Solid Waste District. Information about recycling and how to dispose of various types of trash can be found on their website at [www.GUVSWD.org](http://www.GUVSWD.org).

Trash permits run from July 1 through June 30 and can be purchased at Damon Hall for \$30.00 for the first vehicle and \$15.00 for the second vehicle per household.

You will also need a Trash Punch Card - each punch pays for a bag of trash. Cards cost \$54.00 for 10 punches.

Another trash option, Fast Trash, is held at 50 RT 12, across the street from the Hartland Fire Station every Saturday from 8 AM-12 PM. Trash bags are taken at \$5.00 each and no-sort recycling is taken for \$1.00 a container. No sticker is required to use Fast Trash.
